

Freeze Your Buns Series Second Race Results

The second race in the Freeze Your Buns 3 race series organized by the Brockville Road Runners took place on Saturday February 26th, 2011 at the Brockville Memorial Center with a record turnout of 110 participants. Mild but snowy conditions made the course slippery and added to the challenge of the winter event. The 1 Km event was won for the second time in a row by Brittany Alkerton who handled the slippery conditions well and finished with a time of 4:01, a full 20 seconds faster than her time in the first race of the series. Second place went to Claire Cushing in a time of 4:32. Garrett Rodley did a repeat performance of the first race of the series by once again winning the 5 kilometer event. He finished in a time of 17:22 followed closely by John Wynands in 17:37 and Eric Wynands in 17:45. Paula Wiltse was, once again, the first woman across the line in a time of 18:30. The third and final race in the series will be held on Saturday March 26, 2011 at the Brockville Memorial Center with the races starting at 10:00 a.m.
